Designed to prevent corrosion and engine wear, the moisture eliminator, with cooling air fan attached, contains narrow vertical channels that curve to either side. Dry air passes easily through these channels, but moisture droplets and mist collide with the channel walls and collect in special gutters to drain harmlessly away.

Based in Queensland, Australia, Riviera was founded in 1980 and operates a state-of-the-art facility capable of producing over 400 boats per year. Each hull, deck and flybridge is crafted by hand using the latest advances in design. Riviera has 14 dealerships throughout the US and representatives in 30 other countries as well.

Delta "T" Systems moisture eliminators have profiles available in white or black PVC, polypropylene, aluminum and FRP. Housings are available in PVC, aluminum and modified acrylic resin.
